STUDENT CONDUCT RECORDS REQUEST FORM

The 1974 Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act is a federal law (20 U.S.C. 1232g) that protects the privacy of a student's educational record. FERPA applies to all educational institutions receiving funds from the United States Department of Education, from kindergarten through university level. Under FERPA, current and former students have the right to inspect and review their education records.

Current and former students can request to inspect and review their student conduct files by completing this form and returning it to Student Accountability & Community Standards for processing. The request can be mailed or emailed by following the Business day that the
